- 2. Candidates enrolled for M.Phil/Ph.D./PDF in a UGC recognized institution in any of the following social science disciplines are eligible to apply for the course.
 - (i) Sociology and Social Anthropology;
 - (ii) Political Science / Public Administration;
 - (iii) Economics;
 - (iv) International Studies;
 - (v) Social Geography and Population Studies;
 - (vi) Commerce and Management;
 - (vii) Social Psychology;
 - (viii) Education;
 - (ix) Social Linguistics / Socio-Cultural Studies;
 - (x) Law / International Law;
 - (xi) National Security & Strategic Studies; and
